Also in attendance were Superintendent Cliff Williams and acting as Clerk of the Board Sandy Glessner.

Call to Order

At 6:00 p.m. President Bohnenblust called the board meeting to order.

Business Items and Reports

1. Contracts/Approvals/Appointments

Mr. Williams reported that in the August board packet a budget was sent out to the board of education members to review. The board and superintendent spent approximately 30 minutes discussing the packet at the meeting. During the meeting the Superintendent went over the two page introduction pages of the 2018-19 budget hearing and adoption.

Kyle Bohnenblust moved the board establish the 2018-19 Supplemental General Fund at 30 percent of the General Fund budget. Second by Jared Larson and motion carried, 5-0.

Jared Larson moved the board establish the 2018-19 Capital Outlay Fund at 8.000 mills. Second by Nathan Mead and motion carried, 5-0.

Samantha Brown moved to adopt the 2018-19 budget as presented. Second by Kyle Bohnenblust and motion carried, 5-0.

Samantha Brown moved to hire Erik Willimon as the 7-12 wrestling coach for the 2018-19 school year. Second by Jared Larson and motion carried, 5-0.

Jared Larson moved to hire Amanda Kolbek as the student council representative for the 2018-19 school year. Second by Nathan Mead and motion carried, 5-0.


Nathan Mead moved to hire Zoe Abner as the Dance Sponsor for the 2018-19 school year. Second by Samantha Brown and motion carried, 5-0.
