**ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS**            **1. PUBLIC HEARING OF THE REPUBLISHED 2009-10 BUDGET:**  
President Strom opened the USD 378 2009-10 Republished Budget Hearing and turned the meeting over to Superintendent Starnes for an overview of the proposed budget.

Superintendent Starnes stated the proposed republished General Fund Budget is due to an increase in Special Education Funding –Form 118 resulting in an additional approximately \$100,000 spending authority increase. Mr. Starnes stated our Full Time Enrollment Form 150 went up 21.9 FTE. We originally had published at 1169.4, republished after our audit to the 1240.4 and now 1262.3 (up a total of 92.9).

President Strom called for any questions, being none, President Strom closed the public hearing of the USD 378 proposed amended budget for 2009-10.

Tom Henton moved the Board approve the 2009-10 USD 378 Riley County Republished Budget as published and presented. Second by Randy Glenn

Motion carried with five "yes" votes cast.
